In mid-August, our Therapeutic Community Program celebrated a significant milestone as our first two participants successfully completed Phase 1. These veterans, who joined the program at its inception, have shown remarkable dedication and resilience.

During Phase 1, they committed to the foundation of orientation, personal growth, stability, and recovery. Their progress has now allowed them to advance to Phase 2—the Transformation Phase. Here, they will dig deeper into their healing journey, addressing the root causes of their struggles and working closely with their peers and staff to build a stronger, more resilient self.

As they move into this next phase, they are focused on healing past wounds and preparing for the ultimate goal of independence in the community. Their journey is a testament to their strength, and we are proud to support them as they continue to transform their lives.

She makes sure our days run smoothly and coordinates logistics for outside appointments, ensuring every participant gets to their appointments in the community. Dee is a retired Army Veteran who served in Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) (2008-2010) and Operation Enduring Freedom from 2005 to 2006.

She earned the Distinguished Service Medal in March 2021 for her 18-plus years of distinguished service in the New Mexico National Guard. She also earned the Good Conduct Medal in 2005 for exemplary behavior, efficiency and fidelity in active federal service in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

She is working on her bachelor's degree in Psychology to further enhance her skills and her incalculable value to our veterans. We salute Dee.
